Hartmut Ide began his career in 1987 as a quality engineer at suppliers of the automotive industry.

From 1995 until 1998 he worked as head of quality management department in the final assembly plant of ADtranz (today Bombardier) in Kassel, Germany. In 1999 he moved into the business unit Passenger Cars (Mercedes-Benz) of Daimler AG, where he worked as an internal auditor at the plant Untertuerkheim. 2001 he took a new challenge in the central quality management of Mercedes-Benz Car Group in Sindelfingen. He was responsible for coordination of the different IT activities to standardize the interfaces between the suppliers of Daimler and the Q-processes of MBC.
